

A Reimagined Reaffirmation of the Baptismal Identity

"A liturgy of Reaffirmation of Baptismal Identity' to accompany 'Front Porch Conversations' by the West Virginia Conference © 2021; adapted by Pastor Caleb, 2024

Introduction

M: Holy Baptism—it's about who we are—our Identity *together*. So who are we?

P: We are siblings in Christ, called together by name: Called into one Body where there is no lesser or unneeded member. We are the community of the baptized, initiated, incorporated, and given a new birth.

M: By reaffirming our faith today, we renew the holy Covenant as it was declared at our baptism, acknowledging who God calls us to be:

P: People who thirst for justice and righteousness; people who continually offer ourselves for God's transforming action.

M: By reaffirming our faith today, we acknowledge God as the One who gathers us:

P: We are one diverse and beloved community,
God's transforming power and love can be found
within and among us,
which empowers our commitment to Christ's Holy Church

which empowers our commitment to Christ's Holy Church and to God's Kin'dom-building work.

Reaffirming Our Baptismal Identity & Professing Our Faith

M: Who are you?

P: We are a people who renounce the spiritual forces of wickedness, reject the evil powers of this world, and live a life of repentance.

M: Who are you?

P: We are a people who accept the calling to resist evil, injustice, and oppression in all the ways they present themselves.

M: Who are you?

P: We are a people called to break down walls of fear, build bridges of equity, develop relationships with those unlike us, and learn from the rich diversity of God's good creation.

M: Who are you?

P: We are a people who confess Jesus Christ as our Savior, who trust in His grace, and who promise to serve Jesus as Lord.

M: Who are you?

P: We are the Church of Jesus Christ—open to people of all ages, nations, races, and identities.

M: Who are you?

P: We are the Body of Christ, loving one another and our neighbor: those we know and don't know, those with whom we agree and even disagree; we are Christ's representatives in this world.

M: Who are you?

P: We are a people who must remember our baptism daily.
We ask ourselves: Who are we leaving out? Who is not present?
Who has been harmed by the church?
How well are we advancing the mission of Christ?

M: Who are we together?

<u>ALL</u>: We are a people who receive and profess the Christian faith as contained in the Scriptures of the Old & New Testaments.

M: Do you believe in the Abba God, the Creator?

ALL: I believe in God, the Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.

M: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Messiah?

ALL: I believe in Jesus Christ, the only Son, our Lord.

M: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the Advocate of Truth?

<u>ALL</u>: I believe in the Holy Spirit, whose love binds us together.

[water is poured]

Thanksgiving Over the Water:

M: Let us pray:

Pour out this same Holy Spirit upon us and upon this gift of water.

Call to our memory the grace declared to us in our baptism.

For You have washed away our sins, and You clothe us with righteousness throughout our lives, that dying and rising with Christ, we may share in His final victory. Empower us

to grow and live from God's transforming power each day.

<u>ALL</u>: All praise to You, Eternal God, through Your Son Jesus Christ, who with You and the Holy Spirit lives and reigns forever: AMEN!

Remembering Our Baptism

M: So who are we together?

ALL: We are the Baptized Family of God!

[water is used]

M: Remember that you are baptized and be thankful!

ALL: We remember and we are thankful!

A Blessing

M: May the Holy Spirit work within you, that having been born again through the water and through the Spirit, you may live as faithful disciples of Jesus Christ.

P: May it be so!

M: Let us give thanks to God together:

<u>ALL</u>: Almighty God, we rejoice with You and with one another as we remember who we are:

Christians, loyal to Christ,

through this congregation of The United Methodist Church.

Through Your Spirit,

help us to examine what we are doing as Christ's ambassadors so that we, in faithfulness and joy,

can better spread the Good News

and life-giving joy of Christ to all people: AMEN!

procession to the empty cross

(you are now invited to come forward and place your flower on the cross)

(bring your rock forward and place it in the water of the baptismal font; then pick a gem to take out from the water and keep for yourself.)
