While Paul was waiting in Athens for his friends, he was greatly distressed to see that the city was full of idols.

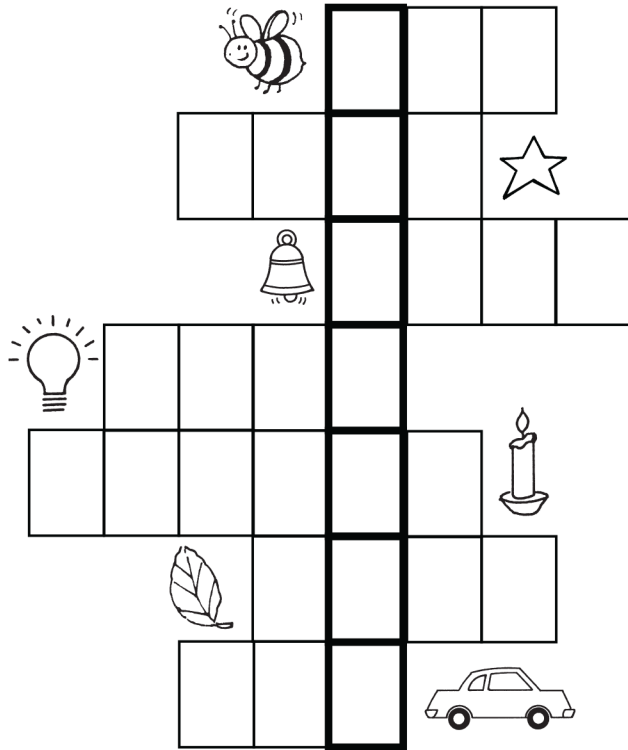
Circle the hidden letters in the picture: A T H E N S
